Supporting studies and scientific research supporting the safety of boxing, in example gumshields with microchips and sensors which can register the number and strength of head punches with a special software

Training courses for Ringside Physicians

Acquisition of an international pool of Ringside Physicians with special focus on young doctors

Regular implementation of courses according to uniform specifications (in Germany, we have had good experience with a 3-day course with theoretical and practical content)

Revision and update of Manual for Ringside Physicians

Medical Support of Cutman Courses
