To ensure transparency, Final Entry Lists will be circulated to all participating teams, keeping everyone informed of potential draw cut-offs. Withdrawals, including late withdrawals, will be managed in accordance with Article 5 of the Competition Rules.

## 5. ENTRY PROCESS

National Federations must confirm the technical and medical standard of the boxers and other Team Members. Participating National Federations are also responsible for submitting the personal data on behalf of each member of their Team, and for ensuring that the personal information provided during the entry process is accurate.

All entries, including reserve boxers, **must be submitted via the World Boxing Xempower Database. Entries submitted by email will not be accepted as valid.**

The Xempower entry process consists of two stages:

- (1) **Creation and verification of athlete and team official profiles.** Once uploaded, World Boxing staff will validate the information. World Boxing aims to validate new profiles within 24 hours of being uploaded.
- (2) **Registration of verified profiles to the competition.** Only athletes and team members approved by World Boxing in the system will be available for selection in the competition registration. All entries are subject to validation by World Boxing following submission.

Detailed instructions on how to use the Xempower system are provided in the National Federation (NF) Registration Guide.

### 5.1 Entry Process – Step by Step

All National Federations must complete the following steps. Failure to complete all steps will result in exclusion from the event.

#### Step 1 – Preliminary Entry & Deposit Payment (MANDATORY)

National Federations must:

- 1) Log into the World Boxing Xempower Database
- 2) Register all athletes, coaches, and team officials to **World Boxing Cup – Stage 2, China**
- 3) Complete the preliminary entry to confirm participation
- 4) An invoice for the deposit will be issued following registration. Athlete validation will be completed by World Boxing.

**Deadline: 17 April 2026 (23:59 CET)**

#### Step 2 – Visa Support Request (IF REQUIRED)

National Federations requiring visa support must submit a visa request to the LOC - [j\\_worldcupchn@sina.com](mailto:j_worldcupchn@sina.com)

Visa letters are issued only upon request and are not generated automatically through Xempower.

**Deadline: 24 April 2026 (23:59 CET)**

### **Step 3 – Final Entry (MANDATORY)**

National Federations must:

- Confirm and finalize all athletes, coaches, and team officials on the Xempower Database
- Ensure all reserve boxers are also registered within the competition section

Following the final entry, the balance invoice will be issued to teams that have paid the deposit.

**Deadline: 24 April 2026 (23:59 CET)**

### **Step 4 – Accommodation & Rooming List (MANDATORY)**

All teams must:

- Submit their accommodation request and rooming list to the LOC
- Book accommodation exclusively through the LOC (direct hotel bookings are not permitted)

The LOC will coordinate directly with each team manager following confirmation of entries from World Boxing. Teams remain responsible for submitting their rooming list by the deadline.

**Deadline: 5 May 2026 (23:59 CET)**

### **Step 5 – Final Payment (MANDATORY)**

All outstanding invoices must be paid in full.

- Accreditation will only be issued upon full payment of accommodation costs

### **Step 6 – Arrival & Departure Information (MANDATORY)**

All teams must:

- Submit full travel details (arrival and departure) via the Xempower Database

- **1 Team Doctor (must be registered within their NOC/NF)**
- **1 Physiotherapist**
- **1 Dietitian/Nutritionist**

Coaches with ringside access:

- **1-3 Boxers: Up to 3 Coaches**
- **4-8 Boxers: Up to 6 Coaches**
- **9-20 Boxers: Up to 8 Coaches**

It is the responsibility of participating National Federations to ensure that all team members are qualified to perform their duties.

## 5.2. Boxing entries check

The Boxing Entries check is the final part of the event entry process. Exact appointment times and locations will be communicated to teams in advance and displayed at the event hotel.

The Boxing Entries Check is mandatory for all Teams, and teams should make all necessary arrangements to arrive timely for their respective appointment.

Each Team may appoint a maximum of two people to attend its Boxing Entries check (e.g. Team Manager and the Team Doctor).

In order to be cleared for the competition, Teams must provide the following documents for each boxer, signed and completed as required:

- Passport
- Record Book (with annual medical examination completed within the previous 12 months).
- Medical Certificate issued within the previous 3 months, signed by the National Federation doctor.
- Declaration of Non-Pregnancy Form (Women boxers only), signed by the boxer/legal guardian.
- Uniforms (red and blue) per World Boxing Competition Rules.
- Gender Test for Men and Women (Older than 18 years as per the World Boxing Sex Eligibility Policy).

All National Federations are strongly advised to complete the required gender testing in their home country prior to arrival.

For teams that are unable to conduct the test domestically and wish to complete it in China, the Organizing Committee can provide information on a designated testing institution located in Beijing (Note: the competition will be held in Guiyang, not Beijing).

Teams choosing this option must independently contact the institution and arrange the testing in advance and ensure that athletes travel to Beijing accordingly. Please note that the processing time for test results is expected to be no less than Six (6) working days. Teams are responsible for making adequate time arrangements to avoid any impact on event registration.

To complete the Boxing Entries process and receive accreditations, Teams must have fully settled their accommodation costs with the LOC.

**Important:** Failure to attend the Boxing Entries Check per scheduled appointment by any Team will lead to the exclusion of the entire Team from taking part in the event.

## 6. VISA & ENTRY TO THE HOST COUNTRY

LOC will provide assistance to participating Teams requiring Visas but cannot guarantee their acquisition. You can find out if a visa is needed through the link: <https://www.visaforchina.cn/>  
If you are a citizen who requires a visa to come to China, you can make inquiries by logging onto the embassy website of your country in China.

**The deadline to submit requests for visa support letters is 24 April 2026.**

Passports of all Boxing participants must be valid for at least six months from the date of arrival and must contain blank page(s) for visa(s) and stamps.

It is the responsibility of participating National Federations to ensure that their Team respect the conditions of stay defined by the Government of the country hosting the event. If any participant does not respect these conditions, any costs arising will be borne by the respective National Federation.

## 7. INTERNATIONAL TRANSPORTATION

## 8. GROUND TRANSPORTATION

## 11. IMAGE RIGHTS & VIDEO RECORDING

The LOC will film the event for broadcast, promotional videos and official event photographers will take still images of boxers before and during the event. All training sessions will be open to the accredited media unless a Team specifically requests otherwise. By participating in the event, each Team Member agrees to release his/her image rights to World Boxing and the LOC.

Video recording of bouts for broadcasting purposes of any kind (including social media) will not be allowed.

National Federations may be allowed to record bouts of their boxers using only one camera per ring, exclusively for technical purposes. A specific location in the venue will be reserved for this purpose.

## 12. MEDICAL SERVICES

The LOC will provide first aid during the entire event period to any participant who suffers from a sports injury contracted during the event.

## 13. ANTI-DOPING

Doping control will be conducted in accordance with World Boxing Anti-Doping Rules and World Anti-Doping Code. According to WADA regulations, blood testing may be conducted during World Boxing Competitions.

## 14. INSURANCE

All accredited participants must have their own travel, medical, repatriation and liability insurance covering the entire event and travel period.

## 15. TRAINING CAMP AND ACCLIMATIZATION

From **03 June 2026 to 12 June 2026** LOC will provide a “Training Camp and Acclimatization” facilities, with special charges. The training camp will be held at the Guiyang Boxing Training Base. LOC will make 400 places available. Teams may arrive and check-in on 02 June 2026.

- EUR 110 for single room, per person, per night, with breakfast, lunch and dinner
- EUR 100 for double room, per person, per night, with breakfast, lunch and dinner

## 17. HOST CITY INFORMATION

**Guiyang City, Guizhou Province** — renowned as the “Summer Capital of China” and “City of Forests” offers exceptional environmental advantages:
