Medical and Anti-Doping Committee

Purpose

The Medical and Anti-Doping Committee is responsible for matters relating to the health, safety and welfare of boxers.

Responsibilities

The Committee shall:

- Advise on athlete health and welfare policies.
- Promote safe participation in boxing.
- Review medical standards for competitions and training.
- Support the implementation of anti-doping programmes and education.
- Monitor developments in sports medicine and athlete welfare.
- Recommend policies relating to injury prevention and athlete safety.
- Provide advice regarding concussion management and medical protocols.
- Support compliance with the World Anti-Doping Code and related regulations.
- Review medical incidents and provide recommendations for continuous improvement.
