



R&J CERTIFICATION, MAINTENANCE AND RELEGATION SYSTEM

World Boxing R&J – Certification Maintenance

The certification of an R&J is maintained based on their performance. A relegation system based on performance has been developed to ensure R&Js continue to strive for a high-performance level.

This framework evaluates an individual's performance to determine whether they maintain, advance, or drop to a lower certification level. This system ensures that only those consistently meeting the required standards retain their certification level while providing opportunities for improvement and progression.

Advancement Requirements

Current Level	Advancement To	Requirements
National R&J	Continental R&J	• Minimum 5 years certified as National R&J and pass certification with 80% or higher
Continental R&J	InterContinental R&J	• Average score of 81% or higher from previous 3 tournaments
InterContinental R&J	International R&J	• Average score of 85% or higher from previous 3 tournaments
International R&J	Highest Level	• Must maintain 85% or higher

Maintenance Requirements

Certification Level	Requirement to Maintain Status
International R&J	Maintain average score of 85% or higher over previous 3 tournaments
InterContinental R&J	Maintain average score between 81%–84% over previous 3 tournaments
Continental R&J	Maintain average score between 78%–80% over previous 3 tournaments

Relegation Rules

International → InterContinental or lower level

An International R&J will be relegated if:

- Average score falls below 85% over previous 3 tournaments
- Performance scores will determine the level the R&J falls under,
 - 81%–84% InterContinental
 - 78%–80% Continental
 - Under 78% National
- Inactive at World Boxing international competitions for 3 years or more

InterContinental → Continental or lower level

An InterContinental R&J will be relegated if:

- Average score falls below 81% over previous 3 tournaments
- Performance scores will determine the level the R&J falls under,
 - 78%–80% Continental
 - Under 78% National
- Inactive at World Boxing international competitions for 3 years or more

Continental → National Federation

A Continental R&J will be relegated if:

- Average score falls below 78% over previous 3 tournaments
- Inactive at international competition for 4 years or more
- Not in good standing with National Federation for more than 2 years

Key Principle
