



FUNCTION: LEAD R&J EVALUATOR

Purpose of Position:

The Lead R&J Evaluator is responsible for the same duties as the R&J Evaluators. In addition, the role of the Lead R&J Evaluator is to oversee the R&J Evaluators and ensure the proper steps are followed by the evaluators and those in the observer position.

Accountability:

The Lead R&J Evaluator is directly accountable to the Technical Delegate. The Lead R&J Evaluator will undergo a performance evaluation during each competition.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Leads the R&J seminar, held prior to the start of competition.
- Attends the daily ITO Meetings
- Attends a meeting with the R&J Evaluators before the start of competition to review the evaluation criteria and test the database access.
- Attends the daily R&J Evaluator's meeting with the R&J Evaluators to discuss R&J performances in preparation for constructive feedback, possible sanctions, or their recommendations to impose sanctions.
- Attends the daily R&Js Performance meeting with the R&J Evaluators and PBU staff to review the evaluation scores, warning and sanctions.
- Attends the daily R&J Sanctions and Filters meeting with the TD and DC to give general feedback and communicate any necessary R&J sanctions based on the evaluation criteria.
- Conducts daily R&J pre-session meetings to give general critiques and feedback to the R&Js. If necessary, another meeting can be conducted before the second session of the day.
- Responsible for the R&J Evaluators and ensure that their tasks, as per function description, are being executed properly.
- Inform the TD or World Boxing staff immediately, if any wrongdoing is identified or suspicious tendencies or neutrality is in question.
- Ensures that all bouts from each competition day are made for viewing in the R&J lounge.
- Evaluates the performance of the Referees or Judges and rotates positions within the Referee Evaluators, Judge Evaluators, the Judge Observer position or reserve evaluator.
- Responsible for ensuring the best environment for the health, safety and mental state of the R&Js. The Lead R&J Evaluator will be the point of contact for the R&Js and the R&J Evaluators.
- Gathers the R&J evaluators after the competition to finalize the evaluation of each R&J by filling out the "Conduct" and "Comments" section of the Evaluation system.
