



Function: R&J Coordinator

Purpose of Position:

The R&J Coordinator is responsible for summoning the R&Js assigned to each bout and ensuring they are in their correct positions based on the draw sheet.

Accountability:

The R&J Coordinator is directly accountable to the Deputy Technical Delegate. The R&J Coordinator will undergo a performance evaluation during each competition.

Documents to submit:

R&J Draw Sheets per bout to the Announcer and R&J Evaluators after the positions within the FOP of the R&Js have been confirmed.

Note: TV graphics operator may also receive a copy if requested.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Ensures the R&J draw sheet is received 15 minutes before each upcoming bout, by the Draw Commissioner.
- Summons the R&Js to the FOP for each bout according to the R&J draw sheet in a timely manner.
- Ensures the R&Js are in the correct positions within the FOP, based on the R&J draw sheet prior to the start of the bout. In the event there is a mistake, the DTD must be notified immediately.
- Distributes one copy of the R&J draw sheet to the announcer at ringside and one copy to the R&J evaluators. If applicable, the Scoring Operator will print a third copy for the TV graphics operator.
- Summons the R&J to FOP for each bout according to the R&J draw sheet in a timely manner.
- Coordinates the exit of the R&Js and checks if anyone within the R&Js existing is assigned for the next bout.
- Advise the R&Js to take their positions in the correct order.
- Inform the R&Js where to line up as a group before exiting the FOP.
- Ensures the R&Js arrive onto the FOP in a professional manner (no hands in pockets; walking correctly at a good and coordinated pace).
